Kenton Historic Courthouse District Committee Announces Window Replacement Grant

Funds to assist replacing broken and boarded windows, protecting and enhancing HCD buildings.

KENTON - The Kenton Historic Courthouse District Committee (HCD), part of the Hardin County Chamber & Business Alliance, has announced a new Window Replacement Grant.

The HCD committee has set aside a total amount of \$5,000 for a window replacement grant to incentivize and partner with property owners to improve downtown historical buildings. The grant would allow property owners, within a designated area, up to 30% of matching funds to repair or replace any open, broken or boarded window(s) on the second or third levels of the property owners building. An application will be made available and reviewed by the HCD committee on a case-by-case basis. The grant money will be allocated until the funds are no longer available.

Moving forward, to help improve the esthetics and historical character of our downtown buildings, while increasing the longevity of the structures, the HCD committee would be willing to invest funds for the replacement of broken and boarded windows at the lowest expense for the property owners.

The HCD committee plans to coordinate with local contractors and glass/window companies. The committee's goal is to help replace over 150 current windows that are open, broken or boarded within the HCD area.
